## Milestones Ahead: LCRT Continues Progress in 2023

### Upcoming 2023 Milestones

- Continued development of 60% design plans
- Transit Oriented Development (TOD) community meetings
- Review of the project schedule to incorporate 60% and 100% design milestones

The LCRT project continues to move forward as we approach the final months of 2023. The project team is actively developing 60% design plans and continues to engage with stakeholders, on-corridor businesses, communities, and property owners as the project progresses through design.

The team identified a need to evaluate and update three station locations along the corridor to support ridership for LCRT, reflect public and community feedback, and align with other local projects on or near the corridor.

Adding a station at Helm Avenue



Postponing the Durant Avenue station to a later date



Relocating the Huger Street station to the Lee Street area



Relocating the Milford Street station to Rosemont/Magnolia
